The London College of Media and Journalism is part of Media Training and is located in their offices at Studio 14, Aberdeen Studios, 22 Highbury Grove, London N5 2EA.

By Public Transport

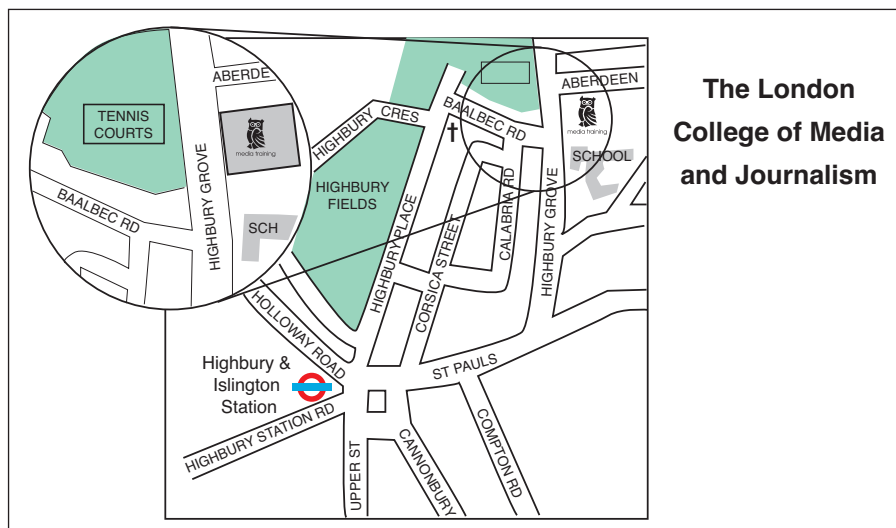
By Tube/Train: Highbury and Islington tube station is one stop north of Kings Cross on the Victoria Line. Highbury and Islington is also a station on the London Overland which runs from Richmond to Stratford, and the Great Northern Line which runs from Moorgate to Letchworth.

The London College of Media and Journalism is an 8 - 10 minute walk from Highbury and Islington station. Leave the tube station and cross Holloway Road at the traffic lights. Walk along Highbury Place (to the right of Barclays Bank). Take the second turning on the right into Baalbec Road. Turn left at the end of Baalbec Road into Highbury Grove, the Aberdeen Studios are approx. 20 metres further along, opposite the park.

By Car: Parking in Highbury is very restricted, we would therefore recommend you take public transport.

By Bus: Buses 4, 19 and 238 stop by the tennis courts immediately outside Aberdeen Studios.

Directions: The London College of Media and Journalism is in Studio 14 of Aberdeen Studios at Media Training. Walk past the security guard and ahead of you will be a sign for the studios. Go up the steps, under the arch and, just past the cafe, turn left. (Do not go through the double doors in front of you.) At the end of the passage, turn right and walk along the side of the building. Go through the double doors opposite the ramp and the large gates. Media Training is the first large red door on the right hand side.
